Professor Andrew Hopkins of the Australian National University is an internationally-renowned presenter, author and consultant in the field of industrial safety and accident analysis.

In 2008, he received the European Process Safety Centre prize for extraordinary contribution to process safety in Europe - the first time the prize was awarded to someone outside of Europe.

He was also consultant to the US Chemical Board investigation of the BP Texas City accident.

Andrew has written numerous articles and books on safety-related topics, and conducted numerous presentations at government, union and industry conferences internationally.
